While the Humane Society of Williamson County provides a regular Low-Cost Spay/Neuter Clinic to the public every Tuesday and Thursday, additional incentives will be given on Tuesday, February 23rd in honor of Spay Day. The first 50 clients to schedule a spay/neuter appointment on this day will receive a Free Rabies Vaccination and a reduced rate of \$5 for Heartworm Tests for animals serviced by the Spay Day Clinic.
